This delightful wine is full of delicate apple and pear.
- Blanc de Blancs**, Frank Family (Carneros, CA) -/75
This wine has beautiful notes of apple and crème brûlée.

Aromatics of green apple, lime, and pears. Fresh and crisp.
- Chardonnay**, Carmenet (California) -/18
New World Style, big, buttery and loaded with oak!

Peach, cream, baking spices and well-integrated oak.
- Chardonnay**, Paul Hobbs (Sonoma, CA) -/58
92 points. Enticing aromas of ripe apple, lemon curd, brioche and white florals. Bright acidity, lingering finish.
- Chardonnay**, Rombauer (Carneros, CA) -/62
91 points. Aromas of bright citrus and melon, layered with creme brulee, baking spices and butter.
- **Viognier**, Grant James (Ramona Valley, CA) -/43
Multi award winning wine with delicate fruit. Food Friendly!
- **Pinot Gris**, Julian Winery (Julian, CA) -/40
Honeysuckle, white peach, ripe pear with a smooth finish.
- Muscadet**, Champ Chapron (Loire, France) -/33
Vibrant citrus acidity with delightful autolytic flavors
- **LeDona**, Los Pilares (San Diego County, CA) -/38
'Pét-Nat' Muscat. Petulant with honey, ginger, and flowers in the nose. Dry with a refreshing bite.
- Riesling**, Paraiso Vineyard (Monterey, CA) -/31
Off-dry, crisp acidity with hints of gardenia and apple.
- **'Hint of Syrah'**, Edwards Winery (Ramona, CA) -/34
Syrah, Petite Sirah and Sauvignon Blanc- delightfully dry!
- Rosé**, Escudo Real (Vinhos Verdes, Spain) -/27
Lightly Petulant with lively strawberry and red currant.
- Rosé**, Sables d'Azur (Côtes de Provence, France) -/33
Clean, elegant minerality with hints of juicy red fruit.

- **Cabernet Franc**, La Serenissima (Warner Springs, CA) -/46
Aged 2 years in American and European oak, it has the fresh fruitiness of a young wine. Forward yet surprisingly complex
- Cabernet Sauvignon**, Stack House (Napa Valley, CA) -/58
90 Points. Dark crushed black cherries, mulberries and cassis. Full-bodied, rich and spicy with a velvety texture
- Cabernet Sauvignon**, Paul Hobbs (Napa, CA) -/80
90 Points. A palate of plums, wild berries, clove and vanilla. Fine tannins from front to finish. Dense and juicy.
- Cabernet Sauvignon**, Stags Leap (Napa, CA) -/95
This 94 point, 2015 Napa Valley Cab is rich and dark, with blackberry, cherry, sweet cinnamon and clove.
- Cabernet Sauvignon**, Frank Family (Rutherford, Napa, CA) -/125
This 94 point, **Rutherford Reserve 2014**, has a wonderfully velvety texture and length, with flavors of black licorice, red currants and a hint of cinnamon.
- **Malbec**, Volcan Mountain Winery (Julian, CA) -/48
This 2016 full bodied Malbec has notes of blackberry, tobacco and spice with a long elegant slightly tannic finish.
- **Malbec**, Grant James (Ramona Valley, CA) -/45
Smokey pomegranate, raspberry and blackberry.
- **Malbec**, Chuparosa Vin. (Ramona Valley, CA) -/57
Complex and smooth with oak notes and rich dark fruit.
- Merlot**, Chateau St. Jean (California) -/28
Beautifully balanced with notes of fresh berry pie, milk chocolate and black tea. Smooth tannins and a juicy finish.
- **Merlot**, La Serenissima (Warner Springs, CA) -/34
Loaded with dark fruit, great acidity and rustic tannins.
- **Petit Verdot**, Sierra Robles (Warner Springs, CA) -/55
Dried plum on the nose, soft finish with dark berries.
- Bordeaux Blend**, Arbalest (Bordeaux, France) -/47
91 points. Arbalest is an elegant 2015 Merlot dominated blend with aromas of graphite, plums and boysenberries.
- Cinq Cepages**, Chateau St. Jean (Sonoma, CA) -/150
This 95 point, 2015 Cab dominated blend has blackberries, raspberries, cassis, black tea, oak spice and a lengthy finish.
- Cote du Roussillon**, Circus Bear (Languedoc-Roussillon, France) -/35
A Rhone blend with 60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Carignan

- Grenache**, Tetu (Languedoc-Roussillon, France) -/40
91 Points. Sweet red fruits, pepper, iris and exotic spices.
- Pinot Noir**, Carmenet (California) -/18
Easy drinking with raspberry, cherry, cedar and spice.
- Pinot Noir**, Etude (Grace Benoist Ranch- Carneros, CA) -/65
Aromas of cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Lush mouthfeel with silky tannins and balanced notes of mineral earth.
- Pinot Noir**, Frank Family (Carneros, CA) -/74
Lively with notes of lavender, red cherry, and cinnamon.
- Pinot Noir**, Balletto (Sexton Hill Vineyard- Russian River, CA) -/75
Deliciously complex notes of bramble berries and black tea. The texture is lush; structured tannins and balanced acid.
- **Petite Sirah**, Hatfield Creek (Ramona Valley, CA) -/45
Big and bold- 100% Estate with delectable tannins!
- **Syrah**, Hatfield Creek (San Diego County, CA) -/40
Smoky, deep, dark, rich. Black pepper, smoke and oak.

Own-Rooted, family grown, big, bold, spicy and delightful!

This 2017 Syrah is a fabulous fruit forward berry sensation.

“Dolcezza” is a fun, local, off-dry style of apple-wine.
- **Viognier**, Julian Winery (Ramona Valley, CA) 9/14.50/40
Round with orange blossom, honeysuckle and grapefruit.
- Chardonnay**, ‘Brioche’ Proven Wines (California) 8/13/35
This ‘Brioche’ Chardonnay is loaded with white peach and pineapple. Medium body with a clean, lengthy finish.
- Vinho Verde**, Escudo Real (Vinhos Verdes, Spain) 6.50/10/28
Floral with aromatic herbs. Fresh with a slight sparkle.
- Sauvignon Blanc**, Matua (Marlborough, NZ) 7.50/12/32
Classic Marlborough style with grapefruit and basil notes.
- Riesling**, Anselmann (Pfalz, Germany) 6.50/10/29
Halbtrocken or ‘half-dry’, crisp and zesty, floral bouquet with lively minerality balancing vibrant citrus flavors.

Reserve Estate Pinot is luscious with dark fruit and earth.

Outstanding red fruit with wood aging on the finish.

Sweet, still wine that is great with cheesecake!

Spicy with caramel and cinnamon. Silky on the long finish.
- Grandfather 20 Year ‘Rare Tawny’**, Penfolds (South Australia)
1 oz 10.00 2.5 oz 18.00
97 Points! Solera aged extended wood maturation.
Aromas of raisin, fruitcake, licorice and roasted walnuts.

Lusciously sweet still wine with tropical fruits and honey.

This Riesling Eiswein has a beautiful deep gold hue with a nose of honey and ripe apricots. On the palate, tropical flavors of mango develop with balanced high acidity.
